HOUSTON, Texas – The 2010 College Cup featuring soccer match between the men of University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC) and Southern Methodist University (SMU) is March 20 at 5 p.m. Sponsored by Houston's Albion Hurricanes Football Club (AHFC), the match is at 7455 Awty School Lane in Houston.

UNC was a NCAA finalist in 2008 and 2009, and Southern Methodist is one of only two NCAA Men's Division 1 soccer programs in Texas. UNC and SMU are two great men's soccer programs in the country and have both been ranked in the NCAA Top 20 on a regular basis over the past decade.

"With only two NCAA Division 1 men's soccer teams in Texas, AHFC wants to expose Texas, the Houston region, urban areas and surrounding suburbs, to some of the best collegiate soccer in the country," said Tony Johnson, AHFC College Assistance Program Director. "This is a great opportunity for all soccer players and fans.

The SMU Mustang team is loaded with players from Texas. 17 players are from Texas and 3 from the Houston area: Blake Milton, a midfielder/forward from Spring Klein Oak High School, Josue Soto, a midfielder from Houston Campbell High School and Pana Vasquez, a forward/midfielder from Houston Cypress Falls High School.

The Tar Heels of North Carolina have four players from Texas: Cameron Brown of Garland Naaman Forest High School, Alex Dixon, a forward/midfielder from Humble Atascocita High School, Stephen McCarthy, a midfielder from Colleyville Nolan Catholic High School and David Rodriguez, a defender from Dallas W.T. White High School. Carlos Somoano, UNC's Assistant coach, is also a native of Houston, TX.

We also hope to have Corey Ashe and Eddie Robinson from the Houston Dynamo as honorary guests. They both played and graduated from UNC.
